Footnotes

TWIRLING CANDY pulled early and prompted the pace outside a rival then stalked off the rail on the backstretch, bid again between horses into the second turn, took a short lead nearing the quarter pole, angled to the inside into the stretch, kicked clear under a mild hand ride passing midstretch and was under a snug hold late. TWEEBSTER stalked outside or alongside a rival, bid three deep into the second turn, continued off the rail on that turn, was not a match for the winner in the stretch but clearly second best. MAKE MUSIC FOR ME angled in and chased inside, moved up along the rail on the backstretch and into the second turn, came out past midstretch and got up late for the show. INDIAN FIREWATER took the early lead and set a pressured pace inside, inched away on the backstretch, battled along the rail into and on the second turn, was momentarily in a bit tight behind the winner into the stretch and weakened some but lost third late. OILISBLACKGOLD angled in and chased between foes or a bit off the rail, split horses again into the second turn, continued outside leaving that turn and three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. HONOUR THE DEPUTY chased inside then split horses on the backstretch, continued just off the fence into and on the second turn and gave way. DO IT ALL chased three deep, dropped back off the fence on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
