GAME ON DUDE hopped slightly in a bit of a slow start, tugged his way along outside a rival moving up in the run to the first turn, bid alongside SKIPSHOT to duel for the lead, put a head in front five eighths out, kicked clear nearing the second turn and proved best under left handed urging and steady handling late. UH OH BANGO pulled inside then came out into the first turn, chased off the rail then outside a rival, went three deep leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, continued off the fence into the stretch, could make no impact on the winner in the final furlong but was clearly second best. VICTORY PETE also pulled outside foes early, angled in leaving the first turn, saved ground chasing the pace, went around a rival leaving the second turn and lacked a rally in the stretch. SKIPSHOT had speed three deep then angled in, dueled inside, tracked the winner along the rail into and on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. EL GATO MALO pulled between horses then angled in to stalk the pace, came off the rail leaving the first turn, was between horses leaving the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
