EXPLOIT had a rail trip, dueled inside YES IT'S TRUE, inched away in midstretch and gamely held off ARISTOTLE under urging. ARISTOTLE stalked the dueling leaders off the rail, was three deep on the turn, bid outside the winner in the stretch but could not get by in a game effort. YES IT'S TRUE set or forced the pace outside the winner, fought back on the turn but came up empty in the final furlong.
