**Footnotes**

ROYAL GEM lagged back along the inside down the hill, came out on the dirt and five wide into the stretch, rallied under urging, drifted in past midstretch but proved best. GOLDEN ARROW chased three deep down the hill, came out some into the stretch, drifted in and steadied off heels past the eighth pole but gained the place. HECANDIGIT went up inside to duel for the lead, fought back along the rail in the stretch, could not match the top pair but held third. MAYOR MURPHY pulled between horses to press the early pace then stalked three deep down the hill, bid three across the course into the stretch and was outfinished. TOURING ENGLAND chased a bit off the rail on the hill, split rivals on the dirt, came out for the stretch and also was outfinished. FEBRUARY STORM tracked the leaders between horses down the hill, angled inward in the stretch and bid along the rail late. IVAN MOTLEY angled in on the hill and also chased between horses, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. FALL FOR ME broke outward, sped to the early lead then dueled outside a rival, battled between horses into the stretch and past midstretch, then weakened. METAPHYSICS steadied when crowded at the start, went up inside to stalk the pace, remained along the rail and also weakened. SHIP AHOY dropped back and settled off the rail, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the stretch run but made no change when they ruled the trouble for the runner-up did not affect the original order of finish.
