**Footnotes**

LUNDY'S LIABILITY (BRZ) saved ground stalking the pace, bid inside into the second turn, gained the advantage in upper stretch, inched away under urging a sixteenth out and gamely prevailed. TRULY A JUDGE sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, dueled outside the winner into and on the second turn and in the stretch, could not match that one late but held the place. CONGRATS close up stalking the pace three deep then outside TOTAL IMPACT on the second turn, came three wide into the stretch and bested the others. SKUKUZA saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted out in upper stretch and lacked the needed rally. TOTAL IMPACT (CHI) well placed stalking the pace between foes then a bit off the rail on the second turn, weakened in the stretch. ASONG FOR BILLY unhurried outside a rival then off the rail, came out into the stretch, angled inward in midstretch and did not rally. STAR CROSS (ARG) pulled his way along outside a rival chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch, was a bit crowded in upper stretch and weakened. EPICENTRE angled in early and saved ground off the pace, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and failed to menace. GO BOB (ARG) unhurried inside early, was pulled up when lame on the first turn and vanned off.
