RICKETYRACKETYRUSS pulled her way along on the inside past the stands the first time around, angled off the rail around the first turn, moved up outside on the second turn, took the lead while drifting out some leaving the furlong marker, came out again in deep stretch and held for the score. CADAZZLE chased on the inside around the first turn, chased inside a rival into down the backstretch, angled off the inside around the second turn, came into the stretch three wide, rallied on the outside in the final furlong and gained the place on the wire. WORKING AT NIGHT pulled to the early lead past the stands, opened up a commanding advantage around the first turn, maintained a clear edge to the second turn, was challenged for the lead leaving the furlong marker, battled back on the inside and lost the place in the final yards. SO SHE DANCES chased outside a rival down the backstretch, came into the lane four wide and lacked a sufficient rally in the final furlong. HIGHLY COMPOSED (GB) was between foes in the early going, chased on the inside down the backstretch and around the turn, remained on the wood in the final furlong and could not make up the needed ground. DOMINATING HOLIDAY crossed over to stalk the pacesetter into the first turn, remained closest to the leader to the second turn, fell back between foes on the turn, gave way and was eased in the final furlong. GO TENA GO chased off the rail past the stands the first time, drifted out while being pulled up into the first turn and was vanned off.
