MANISTIQUE leaned back a bit at the start but was quickly into stride, split rivals nearing the first turn and went outside MAGICAL ALLURE, stalked or forced that rival's pace to the stretch, gained a slim lead in midstretch and pulled clear under urging. MAGICAL ALLURE went to the front quickly, set the pace a bit off the rail, drifted to the wood while fighting back under left handed urging in the stretch and could not match the winner late while clearly second best. GOURMET GIRL stalked the pace a bit off the rail, angled in for the second turn, came out into the stretch, could not catch either of the top pair but edged TRANQUILITY LAKE for third. TRANQUILITY LAKE pulled her way along between rivals on the backstretch, continued outside GOURMET GIRL on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened some. ALLEGEDLY YOURS saved ground, was roused on the second turn and had no response. BLACK VELVET (FR) outrun toward the inside, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. GLORIOUS stalked the pace three deep, angled in some on the second turn and gave way.
