MAN AMONG MEN bumped at the start, pulled his way along a bit off the rail to stalk the pace, came out on the backstretch, bid three deep leaving the second turn, gained the lead approaching the stretch, kicked clear and held under urging. EMPIRE MAKER angled in and saved ground off the pace, moved up inside leaving the backstretch and on the second turn, came off the rail for room approaching the quarter pole, split rivals in upper stretch then finished with interest inside. SPENSIVE settled off the rail, went outside on the backstretch, advanced four wide into and on the second turn and into the stretch but cold not match the top pair while best of the rest. TEN MOST WANTED bumped between horses at the start, prompted the pace outside a rival then between foes leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. PINE FOR JAVA chased outside a rival on the first turn then a bit off the rail, was between horses into the second turn, came out into the stretch and also weakened. TRUCKLE FEATURE bumped at the break, pulled his way to the front, duled inside, was in a bit tight while dropping back into the stretch and had little left. STORM GULCH bumped lightly at the start, stalked the pace outside, fell back into the second turn, gave way readily and was eased.
