Footnotes

STARDOM BOUND angled in and settled inside, moved up on the second turn, waited a bit off heels leaving that turn, swung out into the stretch and again in upper stretch, gained the advantage four wide a sixteenth out, drifted in but proved best under some light urging and steady handling. HAKA chased outside a rival or off the rail, went three deep into and on the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and just got the place. SAUCEY EVENING three deep into the first turn, angled in and chased inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch, bid between horses a sixteenth out and held third. NAN stalked off the rail then outside a rival, went three deep on the second turn, bid three wide leaving that turn, gained the advantage in the stretch, fought back past midstretch and was outfinished for a minor award late. AFRICAN SKIES (GB) stalked inside then a bit off the rail, bid between foes leaving the second turn and into the stretch, fought back in midstretch and weakened late. CENTURY PARK close up stalking the pace off the rail then between horses into the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. TORO BONITO broke a bit slowly, angled in and settled outside a rival then off the rail on the second turn and did not rally. PINKARELLA also broke a bit slowly, pulled her way to the front and angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, duelled along the rail on the second turn and weakened in the stretch.
