Footnotes

VAGABOND SHOES (IRE) came off the rail in the stretch the first time, chased outside a rival, went three deep leaving the second turn and five wide into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging to gain the lead in deep stretch ad proved best. SI SAGE (FR) bumped at the start, drifted out crossing the dirt, angled in and pulled his way along to stalk the pace inside, came out into the stretch and rallied between foes late. LUCAYAN (FR) a bit slow to begin and bumped between foes early, settled outside then alongside a rival, came out on the second turn and five wide into the stretch and rallied late for the show. SEGWAY dueled outside a rival, gained the lead in the stretch, drifted in a bit and bumped his pace rival while between foes in deep stretch and was outfinished late. DUBAI YOU X Y Z wide on the hill, angled in and chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch and had a late bid between foes. JERANIMO unhurried and angled in early, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and found his best stride late. SLIM SHADEY (GB) took the early lead and set a pressured pace inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch, was bumped and forced in a bit between foes in deep stretch and weakened some late. TEMERAINE angled in and chased outside a rival then inside, moved up in the stretch, split horses in tight quarters with a rally in deep stretch and steadied late. UTOPIAN angled in and chased inside then between foes into and on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. POWER FOOT pulled his way between horses then angled in and stalked inside, continued along the rail in the stretch and steadied sharply in tight approaching the wire. BIO PRO bumped at the start, pulled between rivals then stalked outside a foe or off the rail, bid three deep leaving the backstretch, dropped back four wide between foes into the stretch and weakened. Following a stewards' inquiry, SEGWAY was disqualified and placed tenth for interference in deep stretch.
