**Footnotes**

CANDY BOY saved ground chasing the pace, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch, bid three deep under left handed urging in midstretch, gained a slim advantage in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. CHITU bobbed after the start, had speed three deep, stalked outside on the first turn then bid alongside a rival to duel for the lead, battled between foes on the second turn, put a head in front into the stretch, fought back just off the rail in the final furlong and could not quite match the winner late. MIDNIGHT HAWK pulled between horses then stalked outside, bid three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, fought back between rivals in midstretch and weakened some late. DIAMOND BACHELOR had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. HOME RUN KITTEN three deep early, chased off the rail then inside on the backstretch and into the second turn, came out leaving that turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. COOL SAMURAI allowed to settle off the rail then outside a rival on the backstretch, continued off the inside on the second turn, angled in some nearing the stretch and did off rally. EL NINO TERRIBLE had speed between horses then stalked a bit off the rail, dropped back leaving the second turn, came out into the stretch and weakened.
