Footnotes

WILD AND WISE stalked the pace outside a rival, bid three deep leaving the second turn and into the stretch, ducked out under the left handed whip in upper stretch, bid outside the leader, and gamely prevailed under strong handling. SWORDFISH had good early speed and pressed the pace outside a rival under a long hold, put a head in front leaving the second turn, inched away in the stretch, fought back inside the winner and went willingly to the wire. SPECIAL TIMES saved ground without early speed, continued inside to the stretch, came out a bit and just got the show. UNBRIDLED TIME sped to the early lead and angled in, dueled inside the runner-up to upper stretch and weakened. GOLDEN TICKET pulled early then settled off the rail, continued outside on the backstretch and alongside a rival on the second turn, drifted inward in the stretch and weakened. DIM SUMS was well placed saving ground stalking the pace, dropped back on the second turn and gave way.
