Footnotes

SEARCHER four wide into the first turn, advanced outside on the backstretch and into the second turn, bid outside a rival on that bend, took a short lead nearing midstretch and gamely inched away under urging. BATTLER BOB unhurried off the rail then outside on the backstretch, advanced three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and finished well. CARSON CITY SLEW stalked the pace outside a rival, took a short lead just past the half mile pole, dueled inside the winner on the second turn and until just past midstretch, then could not match the top pair but held third. MISSED YOU saved ground close up stalking the pace, came out in upper stretch and lacked the needed late response. STRIVE settled in midpack along the inside, came out leaving the second turn, waited off heels briefly in upper stretch and could not offer the necessary late kick. JOHAR was in a good position chasing between horses then outside a rival on the second turn and weakened. SIX G'S pulled early and was in a bit tight into the first turn, chased a bit off the rail, angled in for the stretch and did not rally. DOC'S ALLOWANCE was rank and steadied off heels into the first turn, chased off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. SUAVE METEORITE without early speed off the rail, dropped well back on the backstretch and was eased but walked off. DISTINCTION sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, was pulled between horses passing the half mile pole and was vanned off.
