Footnotes

COMPOSURE stumbled at the start, stalked between horses on the first turn then a bit off the rail, angled in leaving the second turn, altered path outside in midstretch and determinedly wore down ELLOLUV late under urging late. ELLOLUV sped to the early lead, dueled between horses on the first turn, set a pressured pace a bit off the rail, inched away leaving the second turn, drifted inward in midstretch and held on well but was edged late. WATCHING YOU forced the pace three deep then outside the runner-up to the stretch, was no match for the top pair but clearly best of the rest. PUXA SACO came off the rail and went three deep on the first turn, stalked off the rail thereafter to the stretch and weakened. MADDIE'S CHARM was in a good position stalking the pace four wide but gave way in the stretch. FAVOLA (GB) off a bit slowly, pulled her way up to prompt the pace inside on the first turn, stalked along the rail on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and also gave way.
