Footnotes

QUITYERBELLYACHING chased between horses then outside a rival on the turn, angled to the inside past midstretch and rallied under urging to prove best. BAD BIG AL stalked inside then off the rail on the turn, came out into the stretch, bid three deep a sixteenth out and was second best. CAVANAUGH chased outside then three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and just got the show. RIVER ROYAL had speed three deep then dueled outside a rival, inched away into the stretch, fought back inside the top pair in deep stretch and was edged late for third. CRIMSON DYNAMO settled outside then off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch, came out on the turn and three deep into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. NYMEGEN PITA chased between foes then off the rail, went outside on the turn and four wide into the stretch and improved position. KISSIN THE COBRA stalked outside a rival then off the rail, swung out into the stretch and lacked the needed response. TOUCH CONTINENT stalked between horses then a bit off the rail on the turn and weakened in the stretch. I LIKE BLACKHAWKS hopped slightly in a slow start, settled off the rail then angled in leaving the backstretch and failed to menace. BEEK OF CAIRO chased a bit off the rail, was between horses into the stretch and did not rally. PARISIAN ART had speed between foes then angled in and dueled inside but weakened in the stretch. ZOOMIN ZABEL chased outside then four wide on the backstretch, dropped back on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and also weakened. MAGNIFICENTMANDATE broke a bit slowly, went up a bit off the rail to stalk the pace, continued inside leaving the backstretch and on the turn and had little left for the stretch.
