Footnotes

SNOWFLAKE (IRE) off a bit slowly, moved up inside early, came out on the hill and three deep nearing the dirt, entered the stretch four wide and rallied under a tap of the whip while drifting in to prove best. RAMONA GIRL unhurried inside down the hill, came out three deep into the stretch and finished well to get second late. DIAMOND EMBLEM had good early speed then stalked off the rail, came out into the stretch, gained the lead in upper stretch, drifted in, could not hold off the winner and just lost the place. BELLE STORY chased between horses then outside a rival down the hill and lacked the needed late response. DOUBLE DIPSEA (IRE) went up inside to take command early, set the pace along the rail and weakened once headed. WINTER HOUSE cut the corner at the right hand curve then angled in and saved ground without early speed, came out in upper stretch and improved position. LEAF STORM between horses early, steadied at the right hand curve and dropped back four wide, continued three deep leaving the hill and did not rally. VELVET BROWN close up chasing the leader along the inside, bobbed crossing the dirt, dropped back and weakened. LIL'OCANEPA angled in and chased outside a rival, angled in again crossing the dirt and also weakened.
