EL VINO chased outside, went three deep into the stretch, drifted out under left handed urging through the final furlong but gained the lead nearing the wire and gamely prevailed. SHEDIK (FR) chased a bit off the rail, came out in upper stretch and again in midstretch, was floated to the far outside in the final sixteenth but finished well. MR. BOSSY PANTS stalked off the rail then outside a rival, bid three deep into the stretch, gained the advantage in midstretch, drifted out despite right handed urging past midstretch, fought back between foes in deep stretch and went on willingly to the wire. OAK KYE WHY a bit slow to begin, went up toward the inside to press the pace, stalked along the rail on the hill, re-bid from the fence in midstretch, fought back until the final stages and was outfinished late. WARNING SONG stalked a bit off the rail then inside, came out some in upper stretch, steadied twice in midstretch when in a bit close off heels, found room around a rival but could not quite summon the necessary late kick. EL ADELANTADO sped to the early lead, dueled outside a rival then inched away on the hill, fought back between horses into the stretch and until past midstretch and weakened late. TUCKY broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch and lacked a rally, then did not return to be unsaddled and was vanned off. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
