Footnotes

MUCHOS BESOS angled in and went up inside to duel for the lead, took a short advantage early on the second turn, inched away a quarter mile out and drew off in the stretch under some urging. BAY RUSH settled outside a rival then off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted in but gained the place. SHOWMETHEMONEYJIM had speed outside then dueled three deep, angled in some into the stretch and just held third. AWESOME YEAR saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and just missed the show. DEAL' EM four wide into the first turn, stalked off the rail, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. MAX COOPER sped to the early lead off the rail, dueled between horses, dropped back leaving the second turn and into the stretch, drifted in and also weakened. JUST TRIPPING off a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground then broke down on the first turn.
