Footnotes

CAPECHE angled inward leaving the backstretch, tucked in behind leaders and awaited room into the stretch, split foes in upper stretch and wore down MAURA'S DIAMOND in the drive. MAURA'S DIAMOND stepped to the front from between foes, set a pressured pace to the lane, dug in gamely from the inside and only gave ground grudgingly late. GOLD MEDALLION lagged well back early, swung out nearing the top of the stretch and was caught six wide into the lane, closed willingly from the outside to secure a minor award. IRON ATTRACTION forced the pace three deep, remained three wide around the bend, bumped with JEZABELL QUEEN in upper stretch and weakened. TEE FOR THREE moved up and forced the issue while four deep, remained in that path around the turn and tired in the drive. JENISILVER drifted inward and steadied in the early going, saved ground but never menaced. JEZABELL QUEEN pressed the pace from outside MAURA'S DIAMOND, drifted out a bit and bumped with IRON ATTRACTION in upper stretch, then gave way readily.
