Footnotes

L. A. BULL off a bit in the air, raced three deep into the first turn, stalked the pace off the rail, bid three deep into the stretch, gained the lead in deep stretch and pulled clear under urging. INDY FILM went up inside to vie for command, dueled along the inside to the stretch, came a bit off the rail in the drive and just held second. LIVINGONTHESTRAND four wide on the first turn, continued outside a rival on the backstretch, angled in some for the second turn, steadied around the broken down horse midway on the turn, found the rail into the stretch and rallied to just miss the place. NO WAGER went up three deep to force the pace, battled outside a rival into the stretch and between foes past midstretch and was outfinished. POSITIVE OUTLOOK was not far back a bit off the rail early, angled to the fence on the backstretch, went around a foe on the second turn and lacked a further response. VICTORY DASH pulled his way between rivals to vie for command, dueled between foes, took a bad step on the second turn, was pulled up and was vanned off.
