Footnotes

NOBLE COURT stalked the pace inside, bid between horses nearing the quarter pole to take the lead, inched away in the stretch and held gamely under urging. LAW BREAKER stalked outside the winner, bid three deep and brushed with SPANISH INFLUENCE leaving the turn, continued off the rail into the stretch and finished willingly to just miss. HALF FAMOUS had good early speed and dueled a bit off the rail then inside, inched away past midway on the turn, fought back into the stretch and continued on well to save the show. VAUNT (GB) broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail, moved up some on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. SPANISH INFLUENCE dueled outside a rival, began to weaken on the turn, brushed with the runner-up nearing the quarter pole and steadied briefly between foes, then gave way and was not persevered with in the stretch.
