LAST STING squeezed a bit at the start, settled inside then just off the rail leaving the backstretch, moved up outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, rallied under left handed urging while drifting in some to gain the lead in deep stretch and inched away late. A LITTLE HOT SAUCE pulled his way along inside, inched forward leaving the second turn, came out slightly for room in the stretch and edged foes for second between horses late. WARREN'S KONG broke out a bit, went three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and got up for the place three wide on the line. KESSABTSI pulled his way to the early lead off the rail, angled in and set a pressured pace inside, inched clear on the second turn, fought back in deep stretch, could not match the winner in the final stages but gave ground grudgingly to the others. EL TANGO RAY a bit slow to begin, chased outside a rival, came out when in a bit tight off heels leaving the second turn, swung into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SIBERIAN RUSH pulled between horses then stalked toward the inside, bid alongside the leader on the backstretch then between horses nearing the second turn, stalked between rivals leaving that turn, found the rail in the stretch and weakened. PANTHER'S CLAW pulled hard and pressed the pace outside a rival then stalked early on the backstretch, re-bid three deep approaching the second turn, stalked outside on that bend and three wide into the stretch and weakened. CLEARANCE CLARENCE angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, continued along the rail on the second turn and lacked a response in the stretch.
