Footnotes

BODEMEISTER a bit washy at the gate, sped to the lead three deep then outside a rival, inched away and angled in, set the pace inside, opened up on the second turn, was ridden along for several strides to widen in midstretch and was under a long hold the final sixteenth. WELTER WEIGHT chased outside a rival, came out leaving the second turn and three deep into the stretch and just held second. STIRRED UP settled a bit off the rail then inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and just missed the place. FLEET EAGLE had speed between foes then stalked outside a rival to the stretch, drifted in some and weakened. UNMARKED BILLS unhurried a bit off the rail early, split horses on the backstretch, came three deep into the stretch and improved position. JUST TRIPPING a bit slow to begin, drifted out into the first turn, went up three deep on the backstretch then chased outside, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. JOHN BULLY'S BOB washy at the gate, had speed inside foes then stalked just off the rail, dropped back in the final furlong and weakened. SEA TO SKY pulled his way along inside chasing the pace, continued along the rail on the second turn and had little left for the stretch.
