SHARP LISA broke a bit in the air, stalked the pace off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter on the second turn then put a head in front between foes past the quarter pole, fought back inside the runner-up through the stretch, regained the advantage under urging in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. MEMORETTE chased off the rail, bid three deep leaving the second turn, took a short lead into the stretch, battled outside the winner through a long drive under urging and continued willingly, had the rider lose the whip nearing the wire and was outfinished late. CHARMING COLLEEN sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled along the rail leaving the second turn and into the stretch and weakened but held third. HOT ATTRACTION chased off the inside, went four wide into the second turn, dropped back and angled in leaving that turn and weakened. ON LONDON TIME saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and did not rally. CLASSIC ELEGANCE broke a bit awkwardly then stumbled after the start, was pulled up into the first turn and vanned off.
