Footnotes

COO CACHOO sped to the early lead, inched away on the backstretch, set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch and won clear under urging. REALLY UPTOWN pulled his way up inside to stalk the pace, came a bit off the rail on the turn and into the stretch and just held second. SHOW THE FLAG settled just off the inside then along the rail, cut the corner into the stretch, came out in deep stretch and just missed the place. TOWSER forced the pace outside the winner then stalked alongside the runner-up, came three deep into the stretch, lugged in a bit off heels in upper stretch and weakened. SWISS ARROGANT chased off the rail, lugged out some leaving the turn, was angled in entering the stretch and also weakened. UR TURN DUBAI broke a bit slowly and was squeezed, settled just off the rail, came out off heels leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and did not rally.
