PEACOCK ALLIANCE sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, responded when challenged leaving the turn, inched away again in the

stretch and won clear under urging. STRAY CAT angled in onto foes in the early running, stalked inside, came off the rail leaving the turn and a bit wide into the stretch and edged a rival late for second. WARREN'S PRANCER sent along outside then stalked off the rail, bid alongside the winner leaving the turn and into the stretch, could not match that one in the final furlong. SWONGS broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, split horsed into the stretch and again in deep stretch and found his best stride late. CYNICAL WAGER angled in and stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. ZULU KING broke a bit slowly, steadied and came out off heels early, went between horses on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. WARREN'S WAREHOUSE chased between horses then outside, came out five wide into the stretch and lacked the necessary late kick. IT'S SUPERMAN sent between horses early, stalked outside a rival on the backstretch and turn and did not rally. BOSTON BAKED BEAN settled outside on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. TALE OF THE BAT steadied in tight between horses early, angled in and chased inside and weakened in the stretch. SKIMMING SKIPPER also steadied in tight between foes early, chased a bit off the rail then inside on the turn and did not rally. WARREN'S CONCEPT steadied in tight between horses early, chased outside then three deep, came four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. WILD HOMBRE sent inside, steadied sharply in tight and was bumped into the rail then lost the rider nearing the five eighths pole. Following a stewards' inquiry, STRAY CAT was disqualified and placed last for interference in the early running.
