Footnotes

ALBERGATTI stalked early then took the lead along the inside, inched away leaving the backstretch, set the pace from the rail and proved best under some left handed urging. CHICO D'ORO had speed off the inside then prompted the pace between horses, stalked just off the fence leaving the backstretch and on the turn and through the stretch and was clearly second best. PURELY AWESOME stalked outside then four wide into the turn, continued three deep on the bend and into the stretch, drifted in through the drive and bested the others. INDIAN KNIGHT settled three deep then angled in and chased inside, came a bit off the rail in the stretch and weakened. BRANNIGAN between horses early, bid three deep on the backstretch, stalked between foes into the turn then off the rail, came out into the stretch and also weakened. GRAND EMPIRE saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and failed to menace. MY DIVIDEND a bit slow to begin, settled off the rail, angled in some on the turn and was outrun. CADUCITO hesitated to be away behind the field, settled just off the rail, angled in on the turn and also was outrun.
