CLASSY ATTRACTION stalked four wide then three deep into the turn, bid alongside a rival, took the lead into the stretch, inched clear in midstretch and drew off under some urging. QUEENIE MARINI chased between foes then off the rail, split rivals into the turn, went three deep leaving the bend and four wide into the stretch and gained the place outside horses late. FOLK DANCER dueled outside a rival then inside the winner on the turn, fought back into the stretch, could not match that one in the drive and just lost second. LISA LULU stalked between horses, was in tight into the turn, continued just off the rail into the stretch and was edged for a minor award between foes late. ALL THE LOVE chased outside then four wide into the turn, moved up three deep on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. SIZZLING GOLD pulled her way between horses stalking the pace, steadied sharply in tight into the turn, came out on the turn and five wide into the stretch and did not rally. VICTORY WITH CLASS broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. MOON STONE MADNESS sent inside to stalk the pace, steadied in a bit tight into the turn, split rivals leaving the bend and weakened. TERRIFY had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside, fell back on the turn, was in a bit tight nearing the stretch and also weakened.
