Footnotes

PULPIT'S EXPRESS had speed between horses then angled in, dueled inside, inched away on the backstretch, kicked clear past midway on the second turn, opened up in the stretch and proved best under left handed urging. GO TO THE PULPIT unhurried off the rail early, moved up some leaving the second turn, came four wide into the stretch and just got the place. NOME broke slowly, settled four wide then off the rail, moved up outside on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and edged a rival for third between foes late. TRUETAP broke alertly then dropped well back without early speed, cut the corner into the stretch, split rivals in deep stretch and just missed the show inside. THE BIEN'S GIFT angled in three deep into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, went three deep into the second turn then alongside a foe tracking the winner, came out into the stretch and lacked a further response. SKIP TONY between horses early, settled a bit off the rail, moved up some inside on the backstretch, split horses on the second turn and could not offer the necessary

late kick. INQUISITIVE SON had speed between foes then stalked a bit off the rail or inside, came out a bit into the stretch and weakened. ES LUNA broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail, split horses into the stretch and was not a threat. YANKEE DAN had speed between foes then dueled outside the winner, stalked on the backstretch, dropped back between rivals on the second turn, gave way and was eased late. RESPUESTA SOLIDA sent between horses early, stalked inside, dropped back between foes approaching the second turn, came out into the stretch, also gave way and was eased in the lane. ARATHORN broke inward, chased outside, came three deep into the stretch and had nothing left for the drive and also was eased late.
