TRULY A JUDGE had good early speed and angled in, dueled inside, inched away briefly on the second turn, responded when headed in the stretch and gamely came back on under urging. BONUS PAY DAY went up outside the winner to press the pace, had that one get away briefly on the second turn, bid alongside again into the stretch, gained the advantage in midstretch but was outgamed to the wire. ALL THE GEARS stalked the leaders off the rail, came a bit wide into the stretch and saved the show. LAST PARADE (ARG) chased off the inside, angled in some on the second turn and lacked a further response. OH TAKE (BRZ) allowed to settled along the inside, lagged back on the rail and was always outrun. A claim of foul by the rider of the runner-up against the winner for alleged interference into the stretch was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled the videotape failed to substantiate the claim.
