Footnotes

ORO GRAND off a bit slowly, settled out from the inside, moved up three deep leaving the backstretch, circled four wide into the stretch, rallied to the front under some urging past the eighth pole and proved best under strong handling. TALOBERTO saved ground stalking the leaders, came out on the second turn, gained the advantage three deep into the stretch, could not match the winner late but was clearly second best. TRAIL STRIKER between horses early, dueled outside a rival, was between foes again into the stretch and weakened but held third. REPEATER TROOPER saved ground off the pace, inched forward inside on the second turn, came out into the stretch and bested the others. ARCHIE'S DREAM pulled his way between horses early and steadied off heels into the first turn, chased outside a rival then three deep midway on the second turn and did not rally. AMMANN had good early speed and dueled inside to the stretch, then weakened. WEGOTCHANOW a bit slow to begin, raced three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival, dropped back between foes on the second turn and gave way.
