Footnotes

SMART SPENDING a step slow to begin, stalked inside, awaited room in close off heels on the turn, came out some into the stretch, tried to go between rivals but steadied in tight in midstretch, then surged between horses under urging late to get up. RESPLENDENTLY chased outside then alongside a rival, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and also finished with interest outside rivals. PLEASANT EARTH stalked early then bid inside to duel for the lead, fought back on the turn, gained the advantage past the eighth pole, inched clear nearing the sixteenth marker and continued gamely but was caught late. BIG BAD BOO close up stalking the pace outside a rival then off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and split horses on the line. ESPIRITO SANTO had good early speed off the rail then dueled outside a rival, fought back while drifting in a bit when between horses in midstretch and weakened late. TURBULENCE four wide early, settled off the rail then angled in leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally.
