MCCANN'S MOJAVE chased inside down the hill, came out into the stretch, rallied between foes to gain the lead past midstretch and gamely prevailed under left handed urging. LENNYFROMALIBU cut the corner at the right hand curve then chased outside a rival, also came out into the stretch, bid three deep then outside the winner and continued willingly to the wire. HEMET THOUGHT chased between horses then off the rail down the hill, came out into the stretch and finished with interest. SPINELESSJELLYFISH angled in and chased the leader along the inside, split horses in deep stretch and lacked the needed late kick. RIDE AND SHINE saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary rally. SLEW'S PRINCE quickly sprinted clear, angled in on the hill, widened his advantage, remained clear in midstretch but weakened in the final furlong. BLAIRS GENERAL hopped in the air to be off slowly, trailed off the rail, angled in on the hill and did not rally. GREY MEMO cut the corner at the right hand curve then was in a good position chasing three deep down the hill, came out into the stretch and weakened. Rail on hill at zero.
