Footnotes

GREEN EYED LYDIA dueled three deep then stalked outside a rival midway on the turn, bid again leaving the bend and took a short lead into the stretch,

drifted in some but pulled clear under some urging. THE CAT DID IT stalked between horses, split rivals on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, bid outside the winner but could not match that one in the final furlong while second best. MIMITHEMIDGET a bit slow to begin, went up inside to stalk the pace, came out some in the stretch and picked up the show. RAZI'S STAR sent inside to duel for the lead, inched away briefly on the turn but weakened in the stretch. C R DEELITES between horses early, chased a bit off the rail, came out in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. TOUCHING NOSES broke slowly, settled well off the rail, angled in for the turn and split rivals at the wire. CAMBRIA BREEZE dueled between horses then stalked a bit off the fence on the turn, dropped back into the stretch, drifted out through the drive and weakened. FUEGO DE LUNA chased between foes then outside a rival, split horses on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked a further responses. WINGARDIUM LEVIOSA bobbed at the start, chased outside, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and weakened. ATSASHANARAY broke alertly then dropped back between foes, continued outside on the turn, swung wide into the stretch and was not a factor. IKUMA RED settled three deep then off the rail, angled in on the turn and failed to menace. APRIL'S PROSPECT prompted the pace four wide then stalked outside on the turn, came four wide again into the stretch and gave way.
