Footnotes

MT. DAVIDSON between horses early, angled in and chased inside, came out on the turn and four wide into the stretch, bid outside foes under some left handed urging in midstretch and gamely prevailed. OMEGA MINISTER dueled between horses then outside a rival, was carried out into the stretch, took a short lead between foes in the drive and continued willingly while drifting out. COASTAL SOUVENIR stalked between horses then a bit off the rail, angled in on the turn, bid along the fence in the stretch, put a head in front in deep stretch and also continued willingly to the wire. UNCLE JEEP went up to prompt the pace three deep, stalked outside on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and weakened. DELAWARE DOE stalked between horses on the backstretch, split rivals again leaving the turn and lacked a rally. COMIC CLUB had good early speed and dueled inside, came out into the stretch, was between foes in upper stretch and weakened. LITURGICAL between rivals early, chased outside then dropped back off the rail, angled in on the turn and gave way, then did not return to be unsaddled when lame and was vanned off.
