Footnotes

FOLK DANCER sped between horses to the early lead, set the pace inside, responded when challenged on the second turn, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, inched away nearing the sixteenth marker and won clear under urging. CHOCOLATE DELIGHT three wide early, angled in on the first turn and chased inside, moved up along the rail in the stretch and outfinished a rival for the place. FLASHY DELIGHT pulled her way along inside to stalk the pace, was between horses a half mile out, bid alongside the winner on the second turn and in the stretch, could not match that one in the final sixteenth and was outfinished for second. LILLY'S PERFECT pulled between horses and steadied into the first turn, stalked between horses or outside a rival, angled in a bit off the rail on the second turn and weakened. INNER GROOVE stalked between foes then outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and also weakened. TOWN BELLE chased three deep, dropped back off the rail on the second turn, angled in some, gave way and was eased in the stretch.
