CURVY CAT chased three deep then outside on the hill, came four wide into the stretch, bid outside foes nearing midstretch, gained the lead alongside the runner-up in deep stretch and gamely prevailed under a crack of the whip and strong handling. BEST PRESENT EVER chased between horses then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch, bid between foes nearing midstretch, gained a slim advantage, fought back inside the winner and went willingly to the wire. JUNE CLEAVER settled off the rail then inside on the hill, waited off heels in midstretch, came out past midstretch and gained the show. MAGICAL BAND broke in and a bit slowly, had good early speed and dueled inside, fought back on the hill and into the stretch, weakened some in the final furlong and just lost third. MINDS EYES chased outside a rival, came out into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor award. SIZZLING GOLD had good early speed and dueled outside a rival, fought back leaving the hill, was between foes in upper stretch and weakened. PLAZA DE INDIAS (CHI) broke in and a bit slowly, saved ground stalking the pace, came out some into the stretch, was between foes in upper stretch and also weakened. Rail on hill at 14 feet.
