MUSICAL ECHO (GB) sped to the early lead and angled in, set all the pace inside on a clear lead and held on gamely under urging. VELVET MOONLITE chased outside then three deep, continued alongside a rival on the second turn and into the stretch and went on willingly to the wire. CAMELITA unhurried inside to the second turn, came out leaving that turn and four wide into the stretch, drifted in some but bested the rest. KARLEE'S KITTEN stalked the pace inside, came out on the second turn and three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. CRYPTO'S WILD chased alongside a rival then outside, angled in on the second turn and was not a threat. BEYLA (ARG) chased outside a rival, dropped back on the backstretch and failed to menace. MORE ANGELS stalked outside a rival then between foes, angled in leaving the second turn and weakened. MARK SET GO four wide into the first turn, chased off the rail, angled in some on the second turn, came out into the stretch and also weakened.
