**Footnotes**

FIGEAC stalked the early leaders from the outside down the backstretch and around the turn, entered the stretch four wide and was up for the score on the outside in deep stretch. MENSA HEAT stalked the leaders from between horses into the turn, saved some ground on the turn, was again between foes entering the lane, took the lead in midstretch and was caught in the late stages. FREE LUNCH stalked the early leaders on the rail into the turn, saved ground around the turn, came off the rail at the top of the lane, moved back to the wood in deep stretch and was a clear third at the wire. EXILE was outrun to the stretch, swung out for the drive and passed tiring foes in deep stretch. GHOST RULER prompted the pace on the outside to the top of the lane and gradually weakened in the stretch drive. HASTY TREND had good early speed down the backstretch while off the rail, moved closer to the wood on the turn, led to the top of the lane and gradually weakened on the inside in the final furlong.
