VAUNDELL had speed outside foes to press the pace then stalked off the rail, drifted out some into the stretch, bid again alongside the runner-up in the drive, gained the lead past the eighth pole and inched away under some urging and good handling. ITSSULTRYINTHECAPE went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away on the hill, came out into the stretch, fought back off the rail in the drive and held second. HOT DAMON chased inside down the hill, moved up along the rail into the stretch, bid inside in the drive and edged rivals for the show. ADAM SUANCES settled just off the rail then chased inside, came out into the stretch and was outfinished for a minor award. MARK THE BENCH had speed outside then stalked alongside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. STELLA MARK allowed to settle off the inside, came out leaving the hill and five wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. INDIANSKI chased between horses then outside a rival, came out into the stretch and was not a threat. DE CAR GUY had speed off the rail then angled in and stalked inside to the stretch and weakened. PREMIERE FLYER chased outside then alongside a rival, came out four wide into the stretch and also weakened. NEXT OF KENDRA allowed to settle outside chasing the pace, broke down and fell on the hill. Rail on hill at zero.
