Footnotes

NOBLETY chased outside then alongside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging and good handling to gain the lead in deep stretch. SWIFT WINDS had speed between foes then stalked off the rail, bid alongside a rival down the hill, took a short lead in the stretch, drifted out a bit then in from the whip and held on well but was overtaken late. EL MANUEL (CHI) chased off the rail then inside, came out in midstretch, split horses in deep stretch and continued willingly to the wire. CADILLAC (NZ) off a bit slow, came out early and chased between horses or off the rail, split rivals again leaving the hill, came out in upper stretch and just missed the show. TEN MEROPA allowed to settle inside chasing the pace, continued along the rail in the stretch and could not offer the needed late kick. GIGANTICUS unhurried off the rail early, came out some in the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. HIGH STANDARDS had good early speed off the rail, dueled outside a rival, stalked off the rail leaving the hill and weakened some in the stretch. ORIENT EMPEROR sent inside early, dueled along the rail, inched away between calls on the hill, fought back leaving the hill and in the stretch and weakened late. FIRE BREAK between foes early, chased outside then three deep on the hill, came four wide into the stretch and did not rally. Rail on hill at zero.
