IOTAPA sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, responded when challenged on the backstretch and into the second turn, inched away on that bend, kicked clear under urging in the stretch and proved best. LET FAITH ARISE went three deep into the first turn then stalked outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and continued willingly, could not catch the winner but was clearly second best. STANWYCK a bit slow to begin, angled in and settled inside then went outside a rival into the backstretch to chase the pace, continued off the rail on the second turn, swung out into the stretch and gained the show late. YAHILWA pulled her way along to stalk the pace off the rail, bid outside the winner on the backstretch and second turn, fell back a bit into the stretch, drifted to the inside in the drive and weakened some but just lost third. ONDINE between horses early, stalked the pace inside to the stretch and did not rally. GOLDEN PRODUCTION angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, dropped back on the second turn, drifted out into the stretch and gave way.
