OCEAN TERRACE angled in and dueled inside on the backstretch and turn, battled gamely in along the rail in the stretch, inched away under some urging in deep stretch and proved best. FLY TO THE WIRE saved ground stalking the dueling leaders, came out leaving the turn and into the stretch and edged a rival for second. CARTHAGE had good early speed and dueled outside the winner, drifted out a bit leaving the backstretch, angled in and fought back on the turn and in the stretch, could not match the winner late and just lost the place. TOUCH THE WIRE chased outside then off the rail on the backstretch, continued alongside a rival on the turn and three deep into the stretch and did not rally. IRON LAD (IRE) close up between horses then outside a rival on the backstretch, dropped back on the turn, was between foes again into the stretch and weakened. MR JOE B off a bit slowly, saved ground off the pace and failed to menace. GENERAL GUIDELINES settled off the rail without early speed, angled in approaching the turn and was outrun.
