Footnotes

YODELADYTOO chased off the rail, moved up outside on the turn, took command alongside a rival into the stretch and drew clear under urging. KACHINA DREAM angled in on the backstretch and settled off the pace, inched forward on the turn, was in a bit tight midway on the bend then got through inside, came out in upper stretch and was second best. SWISS PLEASE stalked the pace inside, came a bit off the rail on the turn, was outside a foe nearing the stretch and bested the others. SHIRLEY JEAN sped to the early lead, set the pace inside, dueled inside the winner into the stretch and weakened. WINDOW BOX broke slowly, lagged back a bit off the inside, angled to the rail in the stretch and was not a threat. NINADIVINA chased off the rail then outside a rival, came three deep into the stretch and lacked a further response. SNEAKY JACK bobbled slightly at the start, prompted the pace outside then stalked alongside a rival, continued off the rail on the turn, drifted out some and dropped back in upper stretch, gave way and was eased late.
