Footnotes

TURBO FAN chased between horses then outside leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and rallied under urging to narrowly prevail. TURKISH VICTORY between horses early, stalked off the rail then outside, also came three deep into the stretch, gained a short advantage in midstretch and held on well but was edged late. BERTIE BOY chased between rivals or off the rail, came out into the stretch and just got the show. MAJ. TROUBLE dueled three deep then stalked into the turn, re-bid between horses leaving the turn, fought back inside in midstretch and weakened late. MISSILE EXPRESS chased outside, went four wide on the turn and into the stretch and was edged for the show. FOREST HAWK broke slowly, settled off the rail, advanced outside

leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. QUITE THE MAN stalked a bit off the rail then between horses, angled in on the turn and weakened. FORGOTTEN ONE dueled between horses then stalked off the rail into the turn, dropped back leaving the turn and weakened. MR. WARREN a bit slow to begin, settled off the rail then inside, split rivals leaving the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked a rally. GOODLOOKINDUDE pulled his way up inside, dueled along the rail, inched away into the turn, fought back leaving the turn, then weakened. FIVE FOR THE MONEY settled off the rail then inside, came out on the turn and into the stretch and was not a factor. GRIZHEAD RED had good early speed and stalked inside, was shuffled back into the turn and had little left for the stretch.
