Footnotes

DISTINCTIVE AFLEET prompted the pace outside a rival and between horses midway on the backstretch, took the lead into the stretch, inched away under left handed urging past the eighth pole and held gamely. CHANGE YOUR MASK chased inside or a bit off the rail, continued inside on the second turn, came out leaving that turn and three deep into the stretch and closed willingly to just miss. TURN TO THE KING sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, fought back into the stretch and until midstretch and weakened but bested the others. IN SESSION stalked outside a rival then bid three deep on the backstretch, continued alongside a foe on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened. CRIMSON STAR chased between horses then outside a rival, continued off the inside on the backstretch and second turn, came four wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. NORCO PAL broke out a bit and steadied, angled in and stalked the pace inside, continued toward the rail in the stretch and weakened. LORD IN COMMAND pulled his way along a bit off the rail then angled in on the backstretch, came out some into the second turn and failed to menace.
