Footnotes

CLUE ME IN stalked the pace outside, moved up three deep on the turn and into the stretch to gain the lead, inched away in midstretch and won clear under some urging and steady handling late. MY MAN SUMO chased off the rail then between foes, steadied at the spill into the turn, swung out into the stretch and was clearly second best. TRUMPET PLAYER JAY had speed off the rail then dueled between horses, battled inside on the turn and into the stretch and weakened but held third. FANDINO prompted the pace four wide then three deep into the turn, battled outside a rival on the turn and between foes into the stretch and weakened. BATTLE POINT chased outside on the backstretch and turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. SKIMMING SKIPPER went up inside to press the pace, fell back some while stalking along the rail on the turn and weakened in the drive. THRICE THE VICE prompted the pace between horses, fell back some into the turn, dropped back more leaving the bend and had little left for the stretch. PARTY MANDATE stalked the pace inside, took a couple bad steps then appeared to clip heels into the turn and lost the jockey, then was vanned off. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the incident into the far turn but made no change when they ruled PARTY MANDATE was the cause of his own trouble.
