VIBRATO JAZZ chased inside then a bit off the rail, was between horses on the second turn, lacked room three deep behind rivals into the stretch, came out, split foes past midstretch and rallied under a left handed tap of the whip and good handling to gain the lead three deep in late stretch. LATE NIGHT SKY sped to the early lead, dueled then shook off a foe on the first turn and set the pace inside, held on gamely through the drive but was caught late between horses. CAT'S ENOUGH a bit awkwardly into stride, chased between horses then a bit off the rail, angled in on the first turn, saved ground, got through inside into the stretch, bid along the rail in deep stretch and also went on willingly to the end. QATAR'S PEARL angled in and stalked outside, went three deep on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. ROCKET TRAIN broke inward, angled in and chased a bit off the rail then inside, came out into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and could not offer the necessary response. A DAY AWAY broke in a bit, pulled early then settled inside chasing the pace, came out a bit in the stretch and lacked the needed rally. MONTEGO BAY broke a bit slowly then was squeezed back, settled outside chasing the pace, went three wide on the second turn, swung five wide into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. DANGEROUS DUO angled in and pressed the pace outside a rival then stalked a bit off the rail, was between horses on the second turn, came out some into the stretch, was in a bit tight in upper stretch and weakened. ANIMAUX DEL VIENTO bumped at the start, chased outside a rival then three deep into the second turn, came a bit wide into the stretch and did not rally. LUNE DE CARO hesitated to be away slowly, came off the inside nearing the first turn, went outside a rival early on the backstretch, swung four wide into the stretch and was not a factor. CALLED TO SERVE allowed to settle a bit off

the rail, swung out into the stretch and failed to menace.
