BELLAVINI had speed between horses then stalked inside, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch and rallied under urging to go past the runner-up nearing the wire. T J'S STORMY WIT a bit slow into stride, went up inside to duel for the lead, inched away in the stretch and held on well but was caught late. WILD BELLA pulled her way along inside then a bit off the rail chasing the pace to the stretch, split horses in the final stages to get the show. LIVE THE FORTH had good early speed and duelled between horses, drifted inward in the final furlong and just lost third. FLASHY RAE dueled three deep, also drifted in some in the stretch and weakened in the final furlong but was edged late for a minor award. MEDIO CIEGO bumped between horses at the start, settled off the rail then was kept wide by the riderless horses on the backstretch, angled in some entering the turn, came out four wide into the stretch and finished with some interest. WHISKEY TALKS had speed between horses early then dropped back outside a rival or off the rail, fell back farther on the turn, gave way and was not persevered with late. GOLDEN MIRACLE bumped at the start while between horses and lost the rider in the opening strides. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the start before ruling no other runners were responsible for the trouble to GOLDEN MIRACLE in the early stages.
