Footnotes

DYNAMIC HOST pulled his way along and stalked along the inside, was in a bit tight into the second turn then steadied off heels leaving that turn, got out in upper stretch, bid outside the pacesetter in midstretch, gained the advantage nearing the sixteenth pole and proved best under some urging. GOD OF WAR (BRZ) took the early lead outside foes then inched away and angled in, set the pace inside, fought back when challenged in the final furlong and continued willingly to the wire. ARRAIGNMENT pulled a bit and stalked outside the winner to the stretch, loomed a threat behind the top pair in midstretch, could not match those runners in the final furlong but bested the rest. TIZPAT bobbled a bit at the start, was between foes early then angled in and chased inside the rest of the way and lacked the needed rally. SO ELITE between rivals early, stalked outside a rival or off the rail, came three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late kick. LAMM came off the inside passing the wire the first time, chased outside a rival, swung out into the stretch and did not rally.
